DID YOU KNOW?

The BC Medical Services Plan (MSP) is a payment system based on TRUST.

MSP processes approximately 103 million claims per year, and their default is to pay.

There are three types of auditees

- Those who don't know
- Those who think they know
- Those who deliberately bill inappropriately

There are three types of audits

- Random
- Select
- · On-site

Just because you were paid for it, doesn't mean you billed it correctly!

Audits are never conducted solely on the basis of a tip/complaint received.

BILLING TIPS

- Don't rely on MSP to tell you that you did not bill properly
- Take the time to document what you do
- Read the Preamble to the Payment Schedule
- Ensure all lab or diagnostic tests you order are medically necessary
- Do not destroy appointment records
- Look at your remittances; if something doesn't look right, phone MSP
- If you get advice from MSP billing support, document who, what, and when
- Be cautious about relying on billing advice from colleagues and private pay companies

- Service Vertification audit (random, select)
- Tips (MSP, HAs, colleagues, patients, MOAs)
- Practitioner Profile Reviews
- Special Projects
