- It can alert you to fees or services that are flagged and that could put you at a higher risk of audit
- Understanding the flags on your profile can help you determine whether you need to make changes to your billings
- They are used by the Billing Integrity Program (BIP) in selecting physicians with very high costs for investigation

WHAT IS A MINI-PROFILE?

- An overview of your billings compared to your peer group so you can see if your billings are within the normal statistical boundaries
- Generated for all physicians who receive Fee for Service payments from MSP
- Includes all claim submissions and payments made which identified you as the physician who provided the service, or as the referring practitioner

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

- Identifying whether your billings are within the statistical norm for your peer group enables you to proactively address any potential issues
