



Delegate to the Representative Assembly

BC Family Doctors sends 33 delegates to the Doctors of BC Representative Assembly on behalf of the family doctors of the province.

The primary role of the BC Family Doctors delegates to the Representative Assembly is to represent the interests of family doctors and discuss issues of importance to the profession. The Representative Assembly also provides guidance to the Doctors of BC Board of Directors.

BC Family Doctors celebrates and encourages diversity and is committed to creating an inclusive environment. We invite you to provide any information you are comfortable with sharing to assist us in promoting inclusion.

Mandate and Responsibilities

Based on the Doctors of BC Bylaws, the Representative Assembly shall:

- (a) Elect Directors at Large of the Board from amongst candidates nominated by and from the membership;
- (b) Monitor Board performance;
- (c) Have the power to remove a Director at Large from the Board by special resolution;
- (d) Elect the Speaker and Deputy Speaker of the Representative Assembly from amongst candidates nominated by and from the membership;
- (e) Elect Members-at-Large of the Nominating Committee, Governance Committee and the Audit and Finance Committee from amongst candidates nominated by and from the membership;
- (f) Make recommendation on policy and other broad objectives to the Board, including negotiations;
- (g) Review and approve sending Bylaw amendment proposals from members to referendum; and
- (h) Consider recommendations from the Board.
